

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING EXHIBITION DRIVING ON THE  
STREETS AND HIGHWAYS WITHIN THE CITY OF  
LANESBORO, MINNESOTA.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANESBORO, MINNESOTA DOES ORDAIN:

Subd. 1. Any person or individual driving and or operating a motor vehicle or other vehicle within the limits of the City of Lanesboro in such a manner as to create or cause unnecessary engine noise or tire squeal, skid or slide upon acceleration or stopping; or that simulates a temporary race; or that causes the vehicle to unnecessarily turn abruptly shall be guilty of Exhibition Driving.

Subd. 2. Any person violating the provisions of Section 1 of this Ordinance as above stated shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction for a violation hereof shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$300.00 or by imprisonment in the county jail not to exceed ninety (90) days or both.

Subd. 3. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and publication there in the official newspaper of the City of Lanesboro, Minnesota.
