

Section 815 - Purchase, Consumption or Possession by Minors

Section 815:00. Definition. For purposes of this section, an "alcoholic beverage" is defined as one containing more than one-half of one percent of alcohol by volume.

Section 815:05. Purchase, Consumption or Possession of Alcoholic Beverages. Whoever does any of the acts set forth in the subdivisions which follow shall be guilty of a penal offense.

Subd. 1. No person being under the age of 18 years shall enter premises where alcoholic beverages are sold for the purpose of purchasing, being served or delivered any alcoholic beverage.

Subd. 2. No person, being under the age of 18 years, shall consume, attempt to purchase, purchase, nor attempt to induce another to purchase any alcoholic beverage.

Subd. 3. No person, being under the age of 18 years, shall misrepresent his age for the purpose of inducing the sale or delivery of any alcoholic beverage.

Subd. 4. No person, being under the age of 18 years, shall have in his possession any alcoholic beverage.

Subd. 5. No person shall furnish alcoholic beverage in any form to one not entitled thereto under Subd. 1, 2, 3, and 4 of this section.
