

Section 925 - Disorderly Conduct

Section 925:00. Disorderly Conduct. Every person who shall use any lewd, boisterous, loud, obscene or profane language, or who shall lewdly expose his person, or who shall be guilty of any lascivious, loud, or boisterous behavior or other public indecency, or who shall engage in any fight, affray, or other public disturbance or breach of the peace on any alley, street, highway or other public place within the corporate limits of this municipality or who shall ride or drive any horse or horses, bicycle, tricycle, motorcycle, automobile or other vehicle on any street, alley or highway within the corporate limits of this municipality in a reckless or careless manner or so as to endanger the lives or safety of persons or property (or at a faster rate than ten miles per hour) or who shall ride any bicycle, tricycle, handcart or other vehicle on any sidewalk on any street or highway within the corporate limits of this municipality or who shall annoy, injure, or endanger the safety, health, comfort or repose of any considerable number of persons within the corporate limits of this municipality or who shall unlawfully interfere with, damage, obstruct or tend to obstruct or render dangerous for passage any lake, river, stream, canal or basin or any public square, park, street, alley, or highway within the corporate limits of this municipality or who shall in any way render a considerable number of persons within the corporate limits of this municipality insecure in life or the use of property shall be guilty of a penal offense.
