

#### **70.041 PROVIDING FOR A ONE-WAY STREET**

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A "ONE-WAY" STREET IN THE CITY OF LANESBORO, KNOWN AS THE "TRAIL ROAD"; PROVIDING FOR THE PLACEMENT OF A STOP SIGN AT THE END OF SAID ROAD; AND PROVIDING FOR THE PLACEMENT OF A YIELD SIGN AT THE POINT WHERE KENILWORTH AVENUE NORTH INTERSECTS WITH COFFEE STREET, ALL IN THE CITY OF LANESBORO.

The roadway running parallel with the Root River Trail, located in Block 16, in the City of Lanesboro, is hereby designated as a one-way street traveling in a westerly to easterly direction.

An official stop sign, consistent with the Minnesota Department of Transportation regulations, shall be placed at the point where said trail road enters into the intersection of Kenilworth Avenue and Coffee Street. An official yield sign shall be posted at the point where Kenilworth Avenue North intersects with Coffee Street, so as to compel vehicular traffic traveling on Kenilworth Avenue North to yield the right of way to traffic traveling on Coffee Street. The Lanesboro Street Department is hereby authorized to place the appropriate traffic control devices necessary to implement the provisions of this ordinance, consistent with the regulations of the Minnesota Department of Transportation.
